



We've made some changes to the Registration for the VE26 Conference Program:

Registration

There is no pre-selecting of courses – seating is available on a first-come basis. If you'd like to attend a particular course, we recommend arriving early to secure your seat. Please note that workshops have limited capacity and Optometry Workshops must be purchased separately.

Attendance

Conference attendees must be registered for Education in order to be admitted into courses. Your Education badge (unlimited or single day) will be scanned upon entry. Entry will not be allowed for anyone who is late for a course past the grace period (grace period is 10 min. per course hour).

ABO-NCLE

Vision Expo will report the ABO-NCLE CE credits after the Show. Attendees must provide their ABO-NCLE certification number when registering for Education so the proper ABO-NCLE credits can be reported.

To find an ABO-NCLE Certification ID number and confirm current certification status, individuals should visit the searchable certification database here: [ABO-NCLE Database](#). You can search using your first and last name. Anyone who is currently ABO-NCLE certified will be able to see their certification status and certification ID number.

COPE-ARBO

Attendees must provide their COPE-ARBO OE Tracker number when registering for Education. At the end of each COPE-approved course, Vision Expo will provide a QR code to scan for course credit. Once scanned, your COPE credit will automatically appear in your OE Tracker account. CE Letters

Vision Expo will still provide CE Letters verifying course attendance for those who need to send their CE letters to their State Boards for license renewal. CE Letters will be emailed a few weeks after the Conference.
